



General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) Policy for Slovak School in the World

Effective Date: August 1, 2024

1. Introduction

- Slovak School in the World (hereinafter referred to as the "school") is committed to protecting the privacy and personal data of students, their parents, and legal guardians. This GDPR policy explains how we collect, use, and protect personal data in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (General Data Protection Regulation - GDPR).

2. Data Controller

- The data controller is Slovak School in the World, located at [school address], contact email: info@sksvs.com.

3. Personal Data We Collect

- We collect the following personal data:
 - Identification data: name, surname, date of birth, gender.
 - Contact data: home address, phone number, email address.
 - Academic data: grades, attendance, test results, homework.
 - Health data: health information if necessary for ensuring the safety and health of students.

4. Purpose of Processing Personal Data

- We process personal data of students for the following purposes:
 - Providing educational services and managing school records.
 - Communicating with parents and legal guardians.
 - Ensuring the safety and health of students.
 - Complying with legal obligations.

5. Legal Basis for Processing Personal Data

- We process personal data based on:
 - Consent given by parents or legal guardians.
 - Performance of a contract (providing educational services).
 - Compliance with legal obligations.

- Legitimate interest (e.g., ensuring the safety of students).

6. Data Retention

- We retain personal data for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes for which it was collected or as required by applicable law.

7. Data Subject Rights

- Students and their parents have the following rights:
 - Right to access personal data.
 - Right to rectify inaccurate data.
 - Right to erasure (right to be forgotten).
 - Right to restrict processing.
 - Right to data portability.
 - Right to object to processing.
 - Right to withdraw consent to the processing of personal data.

8. Sharing Personal Data

- Personal data may be shared with the following third parties:
 - IT service providers and technical support.
 - Public authorities (in compliance with legal requirements).
 - Healthcare providers in case of emergency.

9. Data Protection

- We implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect personal data against unauthorized access, loss, destruction, or damage.
